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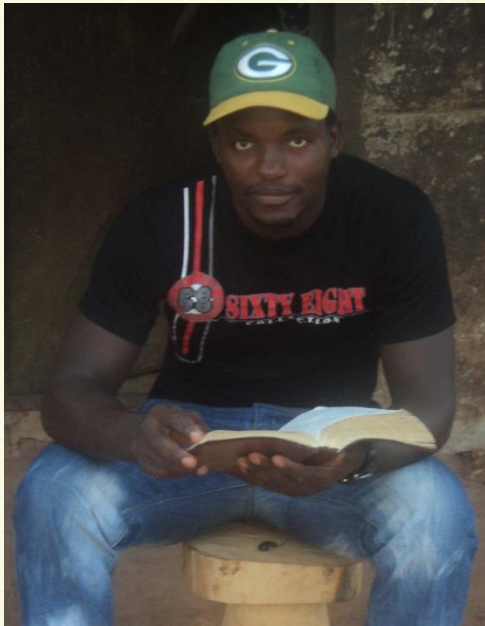

TRAINING LEADERS FOR CHRISTIAN SERVICE

MISSION - In order to meet the need of workers in Guinea-Bissau, the Institute for Development and Evangelism has a mission to train national workers for church planting, education, and community development ministries, through which we aim to serve our communities by addressing their basic needs, and planting churches in the eight regions of the continental Guinea-Bissau.

PROGRAM - Our program will be directed by three specific emphases: character development, ministerial skills, and biblical knowledge. Each of these phases will be intentionally designed to develop our students for vital areas of Christian Ministry. Half of the program will be full-time, which will allow us an environment properly staged for discipleship and character development. The other half will be provided through modules allowing the student to be directed to a particular mission field, where he will be serving in ministry. Thereafter, the

student-leader will return every two months to the Mission for two intensive weeks of lectures. This will assist the students within their ministry and armor them with material for the next six weeks, in which they will continue their studies independently in their place of service. This phase will provide an ideal scenario for the habit of independent study and ministerial opportunities.



INVESTMENT – To effectively function as a training center we need thirty-six scholarships worth \$50.00. Each scholarship will cover housing, food, and education of a national student-leader. You can adopt one or more students during his/their period of studies and promote national workers in this field, through missionary multiplication.

Vision – *To promote the national initiative in the evangelization of Guinea-Bissau so that we may have self-governing, self-sustaining, and self-propagating churches planted in the eight districts of Guinea-Bissau in the next six years of work.*
